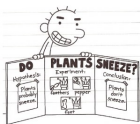
DAY OF VOLUNTEERS NEEDED TO ROCK THIS AUCTION !

WORLD TRAVEL CLUB OFF TO CHINA!

Pathfinder Middle School has 23 students, 8 parents and 5 staff members traveling to China on Sunday, April 9th and will return on Sunday, April 16th. Our first destination will be the city of Beijing where students will be touring the Summer Palace, Beijing Zoo, lunch at Chongxueshanzhuang Restaurant, visit the Forbidden City, the Great Wall, visit Tiananmen Square, go to Jingshan Park and go on the Hutong tour and visit a local middle school. We will then leave Beijing taking the overnight train to the City of Xian. While in Xian we will learn to make dumplings, learn about the Peaking Opera and tour the Old City surrounded by the City Wall, tour the Terracotta Warriors and visit the City Clock Tower. We will also shop at the Muslim Market and experience the food and culture of this amazing city. On Sunday the 16th we will fly from Xian to Beijing and then home to Seattle.
